PCS grad forms Sandstoner Foundation for scholarships; seeks aid

POTSDAM — Tim Dempsey says he wants
to help Potsdam Central High School students

"match academic excellence with financial resources."

Dempsey, an early '80s PCS graduate and

former Potsdam resident, has made some \$10,000 in monetary awards to graduating PCS seniors over the past several years.

Now, he has formalized his efforts by creating the Sandstoner Foundation, an independent nonprofit organization with a local board of directors. Dempsey says the foundation will administer an endowment fund that, as it grows, will provide scholarships to generations of stu-

dents in financial need.

All contributions to the Sandstoner Fund will go directly to the students named to receive the awards, Dempsey says, to avoid financial aid complications. All contributions are tax deductible. Scholarships will be based solely on financial need. "I view these scholarships as loans that the students will give back to someone else at Potsdam when they are financially able to do so," he says.

Half of each contribution will go to the first scholarship awards to be made in the spring of 2001; the other half will go into a fund that can't be drawn on until it reaches \$100,000, according to Demosey.
